### **Kogas warns of LNG shortage**

SEOUL: Korea Gas Corp., or Kogas, said a delay in restructuring of the country's gas industry could result in a liquefied natural gas supply shortage for South Korea, the *Yonhap News Agency* reported Monday.

State-run Kogas couldn't confirm the report.

The Ministry of Commerce, Industry, and Energy has been trying to get approval for the required bills from the South Korean national assembly since late last year. But the bills still haven't been passed as lawmakers have asked the ministry to make revisions and hold a public hearing.

To restructure South Korea's gas industry and privatize Kogas, the government aims to split Kogas' wholesale and import operations into three entities this year. —*Dow Jones*
